
#### **Pastors In Need**


#### **Meeting With Miracles**



## **Helping the Needy**

It was a privilege to visit an isolated rehabilitation centre run by Christians to help alcoholics and drug addicts recover from their addictions.







The photo above shows the centre manager, Andrei who took us on a tour of the facility.

The photo left shows a broken gate with two damaged Russian helmets on the gateposts - a reminder of the tens of thousands of Russian soldiers who lost their lives in a battle in WWII.

In the centre the recovering addicts work on the land looking after many animals such as pigs, chickens and sheep. The centre is almost self-sufficient with crops being planted and a fishery being started (photo below).
