Living conditions are basic. Every day food is prepared in the open kitchen (below). It is very difficult to cook for so many with this kitchen.



Washing is also very basic. The water pump (photo below right) is the only means to wash. It is used to wash pots and pans, clothes and themselves!

At the end of each day the orphans sleep in two rooms (photo below) - one for boys and one for girls. They have very few possessions, which are stored under their beds.



Thanks to many kind donations we were able to help buy clothes, food and sweets for **all** of the orphans. The Bible says that we should visit orphans in their affliction (James 1:27). Thank you for helping me to do this.

I was so blessed to be able to teach several sessions in Pastor Rueben's church (photo left) on subjects such as *The Blood of Jesus*, *The Power of the Spoken Word* and *Faith and Miracles*.

Over three days, hundreds of people attended and were impacted by the messages.

The Crusade

The crusade was held over three evenings and saw crowds of about 1000 for the first two nights and 1700 attend on the last night.



On the first evening we saw 350 responded to the Gospel; on the second evening 327 responded and on the third evening 431 respond.

That makes a grand total of 1108 people who responded to the Gospel at the three crusade! Praise God for His faithfulness.



The local churches were ready and prepared to welcome so many new Christians.

It was a joy to see that so much preparation had been given to the crusade.

There were many other miracles at the crusades - people were healed from arthritic pain, digestive problems, the lame walked and the deaf heard.
