

## The 1994 Rwandan Genocide

The heart of Rwanda was ripped out in 1994 when a staggering 1,000,000 people were massacred in just 100 days!



I visited the Genocide Museum (pictured left showing the flame lit for 100 days each year). This visit was a nauseating experience, seeing photographs and hearing first-hand accounts of how adults and little children were killed: some hacked to death with machetes, others were smashed against brick

walls, still others stamped on until they stopped breathing. The lucky ones were shot! After 45 minutes I had to leave the building to get some air. I have been to the Holocaust Museum in Jerusalem and visited Dachau POW camp in Germany but they did not prepare me for the horror of this genocide.

I have been asked by my friend Pastor Gilbert Habimana (pictured right in the Genocide Museum's Garden of Remembrance) to return to Rwanda to teach at a conference on reconciliation and forgiveness. By the grace of God I will be ministering true Biblical love to hundreds of church leaders who were affected by this crime against humanity.

### Crusade in Mahoko, Rwanda

Flight delays and cancellations, getting run off the road by a maniac driver, attacked by a demoniac wielding a pruning hook, and torrential tropical thunderstorms could not stop this mission to Rwanda!

The 5000+ crowds did not turn up because of the weather but about 3000 attended the crusade for each of the three afternoons resulting in 1079 people giving their lives to Jesus!



Each day, just ten minutes before the crusade was due to start the rain stopped and the sun came out. And so did the people! The Gospel was preached with power and the people were eager to receive Jesus as their Lord.

The devil hates it when people are born again and will try anything to stop them from being saved. One day God showed me that a man approaching me was demonised and to pray for angelic protection. I did.

When he saw me sitting he raised his pruning hook and came at me to attack me. I just looked at him and shook my head; his eyes widened and he fled. I believe that he saw the angels! God is good.



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## Ministering to the Sick

Hundreds came forward for healing each day.



The lady in the picture below came with her face covered in warts but is seen here testifying to God's miraculous healing power—her face was totally cleansed.



The man pictured below had his full sight restored after only being able to see fuzzy outlines for many years.



There were many other healings at the crusades — one man was healed from a broken back and now able to walk, another man was a builder who had fallen from a roof and broken his wrist. He was unable to work but God healed his wrist!

## Children's Workers Conference in

### Mahoko

The ministry paid for The Child Evangelism Fellowship of Rwanda to provide three staff to train about 60 Sunday School teachers who attended a three day conference. What they learnt was outworked practically in the afternoons by teaching children and holding fun events. *About 200 children responded to a call for salvation as a result of this work!*

### Pastors' Conference in Mahoko

About 30 pastors attended a two day conference entitled *The Holy Spirit in Action*. Notepads, pens and refreshments were provided to all pastors. At the end of the conference many testified to the new things they had learnt and how they can teach them to impact their churches.

## Pastors In Need

This ministry's Pastors In Need fund was well used during this visit. Every pastor we met in Rwanda was given a copy of my book "Faith To Receive Your Miracle (And Keep It)" translated in Kinyarwanda (the language of Rwanda). The photograph left shows many happy pastors with their books.



Many other of my books and CDs were given out free of charge to pastors in need in both Rwanda and the Democratic Republic of Congo, who greatly appreciated the opportunity to learn more so they could teach their congregations.

## Goma, Democratic Republic of Congo

The border crossing from Gisenyi in Rwanda to Goma in the Congo went very smoothly – much more so than I had been led to believe – but that was because of the prayers of the saints! The city of Goma has over one million inhabitants and was partially destroyed by the nearby volcano a few years ago. There is a large UN presence in the city and much rebuilding is happening.

I ministered two messages to a group of about 50 pastors (shown below right) about the importance of using our faith.

Lunch and refreshments were provided for the pastors – many of whom are extremely poor and struggle to support their families. It is difficult for us to understand that US\$2 provided a large meal for each pastor and another US\$2 was enough for them to feed their families for one week.

Through your generosity about 50 families were blessed for only US\$200. Thank you.
