
Pastors In Need

His widow, Emmah who is the principal (shown above in the blue dress) offers free education to 4-14 year olds. The school lacks basic resources and the teachers all work without pay. They do a marvellous work, and it was a joy to be with them for a morning.

Sierra Leone Mission Spring 2014

Freetown

In 1792 the city of Freetown was founded by the abolitionist John Clarkson as the first town designated for freed slaves to live in freedom. In the early 1800s thousands of freed slaves from Jamaica and America sailed to Freetown to start new lives there. Liverpool, my home town, became very rich through the slave trade so it was poignant to see some of the city's history.





The photograph above shows one of the many old colonial houses built for the slave traders who worked in the area in the 1700s. The photograph left shows Freetown from the old colonial area, and below right shows a beautiful tropical sunset.

The Crusade

More than 10,000 people heard the Gospel over the three day crusade.

Reaching The Lost

A God of Miracles

The Lord confirmed His word with signs and wonders following. After each evening people came up on to the stage to testify to their healing.





The lady shown left was partially sighted and could only discern shapes when they moved. It reminds me of the man who saw 'men as trees walking' (see Mark 8:24). After the power of God touched her she was able to see perfectly.

The lady in the photograph on the right was lame because her left foot was turned inwards at an angle of 90°. The power of God straightened her foot and she is now able to walk, run and dance. Awesome.



The little girl in the photograph on the right had never spoken or heard. After a dumb and deaf spirit had been cast out (see Mark 9:25) she was able to hear and copy sounds. She is now learning to speak!



Thanksgiving Service



At the Thanksgiving Service on the Sunday over 100 people came to tell what God had done for them.

Juliette (shown left) had been a diabetic all her life. After the first day of the crusade she knew she had been healed and for three days had eat-

en and drank normally and had not taken any insulin!

Agatha (pictured right) had fallen from a building five years previously and had broken her back which had never healed properly resulting in her always being stooped and twisted and in much pain. She is now able to move freely without pain.



Teaching the Found



More than 50 pastors and church leaders attended the Pastors' Conference (photos left and below) where I spent two days teaching on 'The Healing Power of God'.

This teaching on healing was a

revelation to the pastors who were all eager to teach it to their congregations.
