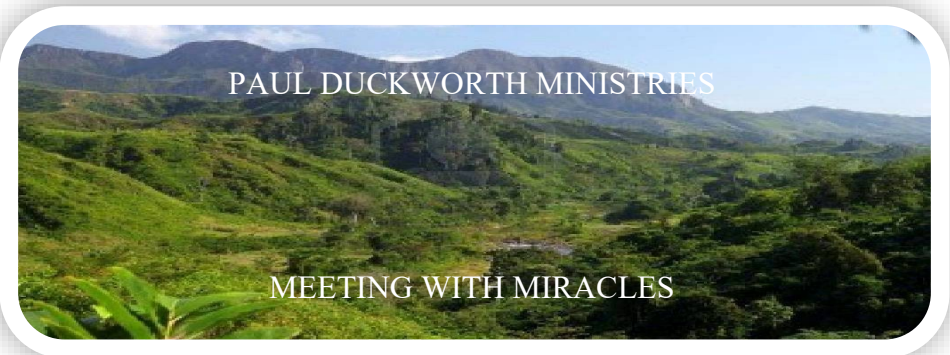

The lady in the photo left had been healed from excessive heavy bleeding. We give all the glory to God.

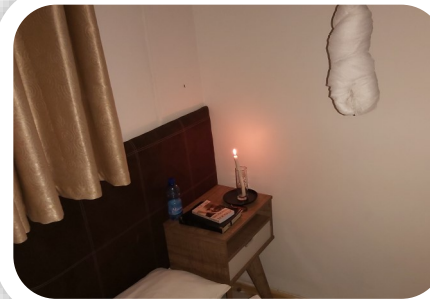


Zambia
